
COMFORT AT THE EXTREMES 2022 EXHIBITION PROSPECTUS



By 2018 it was becoming clear that rapid changes in the global climate meant that related professions and industries would have to make significant changes to design and system specifications to ensure that greenhouse gas emissions were reduced while ensuring that both buildings and their comfort systems could cope with ever more extreme weather events and trends, nowhere more so than in the extreme heat of the Gulf.
